# Room 13's Got Talent

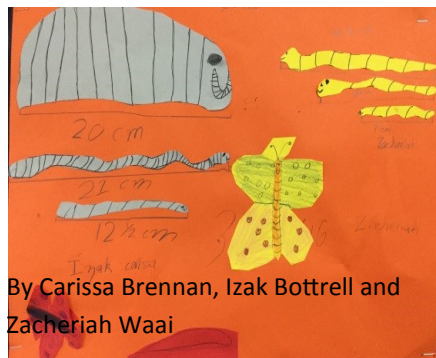
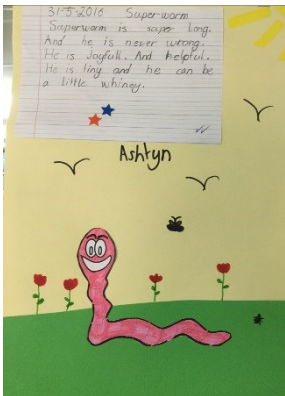


Room 13 is packed with talent as demonstrated in our Assembly. We had magicians, singers and actors share their talents on the day. We are learning that success means having a red-hot go!

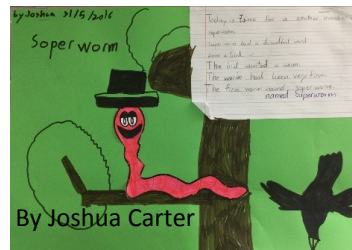

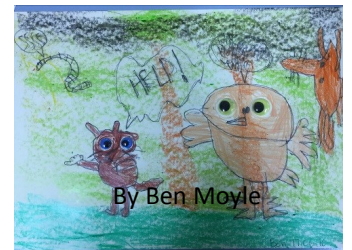
We have been studying author Julia Donaldson. Here is some of our amazing work!
