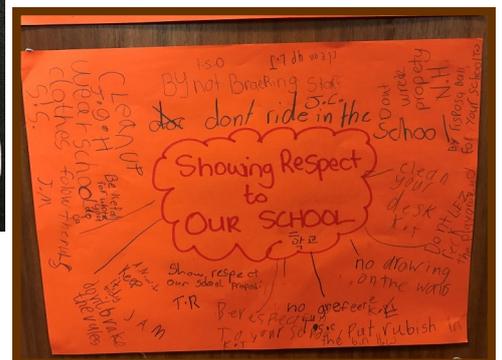
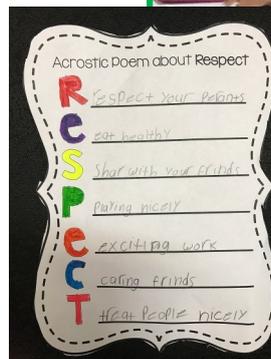
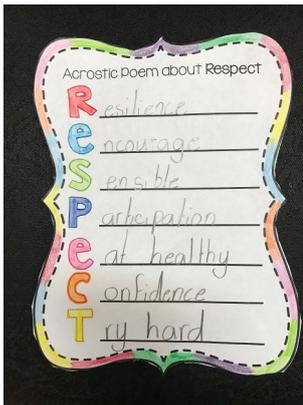
Exploring Room 12

Healthy Lunch Box Items

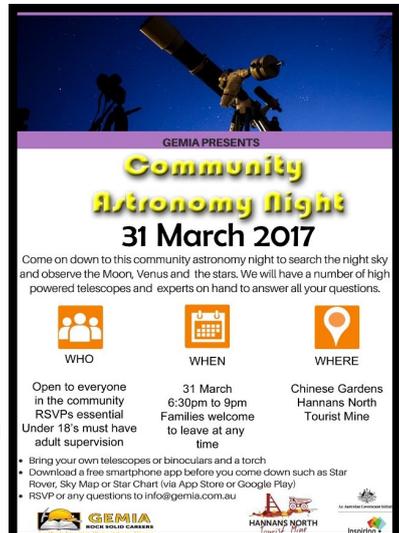
