There will be an official opening of the wonderful classroom mural and the Yarning Circle in Week 10 of this term. In the meantime, I would sincerely like to thank Evolution Mining for this very generous contribution to our school.

Classroom teachers are completing Semester 1 reports. In Week 9 of this term parent/teacher meetings will be offered to the entire school community.
