Upcoming Half-Day Closure

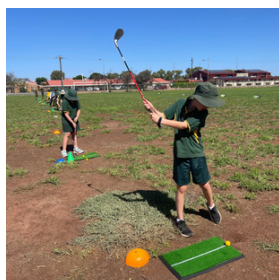
