Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)



Each year, all Australian schools take part in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). This important process helps schools identify and record the support they provide to students with disability, using information they already have on hand.

The purpose of the NCCD is to provide state and federal governments with valuable data to help plan and fund programs that support students with disability across the country.

Please note:

- There is no testing involved, and the NCCD will have no direct impact on your child.
- No individual student is identified in the data provided to the government, your child's privacy and confidentiality are protected at all times.
- The collection, storage, and disclosure of information is strictly regulated under Australian privacy laws.
