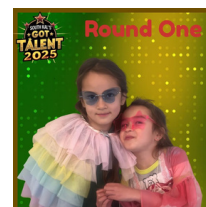
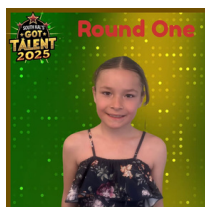

Kindergarten placement letters will be sent out very soon to confirm 2026 placements. Please be aware that Kindergarten is not a mandatory year level of primary education. This means that once available places are filled, any additional enrolments will be placed on a waitlist, and a place is not guaranteed.

To avoid disappointment, please ensure you contact SKPS as soon as possible if your child is set to commence Kindergarten in 2026.
