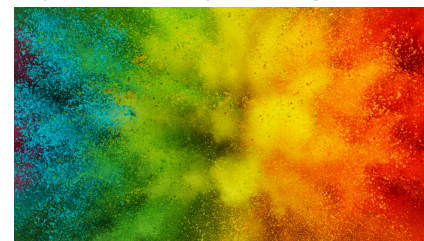

## Starting Strong – Kindergarten Orientation

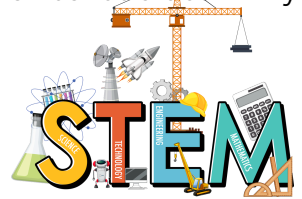
